

Augmented Interval Basics

An **augmented** interval is created by *increasing* a perfect interval *or* a major interval by 1/2 step.

Examples

M3 Major 3rd	aug 3 augmented 3rd	P5 Perfect 5th	aug 5 augmented 5th
